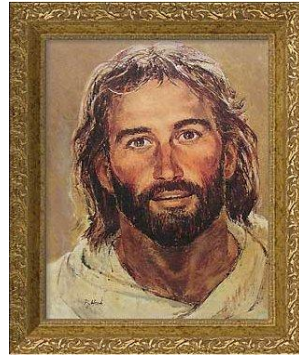

OPENING HYMN "I WANT TO WALK AS A CHILD OF THE LIGHT" #649WOV

WE REFLECT & REJOICE

(inspired from Ephesians 3:1-12 from Epistles Now!, & Isaiah 60: Reverend Collins; & Setting 2 from the LCMS hymnal)

(Please stand if able)

Leader: ¹Arise, shine; for your light has come, and the glory of the Lord has risen upon you. ²For darkness shall cover the earth, and thick darkness the peoples; but the Lord will arise upon you, and his glory will appear over you.

Silence is kept for reflection.

ALL: *We are the Brothers and Sisters of Jesus Christ, coheirs with Christ of all the blessings and riches that our great God has stored up for His children.*

Leader: Today at the experience of Jesus Baptism, we recall our own and are drawn to live into the reality of being His children of Grace and Promise in the world. It is in these insights concerning God's saving Grace that we are to share with the human family about us.

ALL: *How privileged we are, and how responsible that makes us, to live and love and serve according to the precepts of God and by means of the Grace that He has granted us through Jesus Christ! God has redeemed and declared us worthy to be the ministers of Grace. This is our sole purpose and it gives meaning to our lives and enables us to discover joy even in the midst of the trials and conflicts that come our way.*

Please observe a moment of silence for reflection

Leader: Upon this your confession, I, by virtue of my office, as a servant of the Word, announce the Grace of God unto all of you, and in the stead and by the command of my Lord Jesus Christ I forgive you all your sins in the name of the Father and of the Son

Scripture Lessons for the Evening *(please be seated)*

A Reading from the Prophet Isaiah

¹Here is my servant, whom I uphold, my chosen, in whom my soul delights; I have put my spirit upon him; he will bring forth justice to the nations. ²He will not cry or lift up his voice, or make it heard in the street; ³a bruised reed he will not break, and a dimly burning wick he will not quench; he will faithfully bring forth justice. ⁴He will not grow faint or be crushed until he has established justice in the earth; and the coastlands wait for his teaching.

⁵Thus says God, the Lord, who created the heavens and stretched them out, who spread out the earth and what comes from it, who gives breath to the people upon it and spirit to those who walk in it: ⁶I am the Lord, I have called you in righteousness, I have taken you by the hand and kept you; I have given you as a covenant to the people, a light to the nations, ⁷to open the eyes that are blind, to bring out the prisoners from the dungeon, from the prison those who sit in darkness. ⁸I am the Lord, that is my name; my glory I give to no other, nor my praise to idols. ⁹See, the former things have come to pass, and new things I now declare; before they spring forth, I tell you of them.

A Reading from St. Paul's Letter to the Romans

¹What then are we to say? Should we continue in sin in order that grace may abound? ²By no means! How can we who died to sin go on living in it? ³Do you not know that all of us who have been baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death? ⁴Therefore we have been buried with him by baptism into death, so that, just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, so we too might walk in newness of life. ⁵For if we have been united with him in a death like his, we will certainly be united with him in a resurrection like his. ⁶We know that our old self was crucified with him so that the body of sin might be destroyed, and we might no longer be enslaved to sin. ⁷For whoever has died is freed from sin. ⁸But if we have died with Christ, we believe that we will also live with him. ⁹We know that Christ, being raised from the dead, will never die again; death no longer has dominion over him. ¹⁰The death he died, he died to sin, once for all; but the life he lives, he lives to God. ¹¹So you also must consider yourselves dead to sin and alive to God in Christ Jesus.
